Wildflower stones

You can make beautiful wildflower bookmarks using pressed flowers and art paper.

You'll need:

- Art paper, cut into strips
- pressed flowers
- a paintbrush
- tweezers
- white glue

Lay out your dried flowers and art paper on some baking paper.

Before you start gluing, try out how you'd like to place your flowers.




1. Carefully paint your card with glue.



2. Using tweezers, place your flowers onto the card and gently press down the petals. Let the glue dry.

3. Paint a thin layer of glue over the flowers to the edge of the bookmark.
4. Let the glue dry and then add a final coat of glue.



5. Your wildflower bookmarks are ready for you to find your favourite book and start reading!
